If you know of any women who might be interested in a career in the trades, here is an opportunity with LNG/ Fluor- YOUR PLACE LNG Canada **training program**.

This entry level program is designed for women at all stages of their working lives and includes support for all students with referrals with industry partners for current opportunities to get a start on the LNG Canada Site. Successful applicants will attend 4 weeks of training in the Kitimat/Terrace region and be provided temporary living accommodations by LNG Canada and JGC Fluor at Cedar Valley Lodge, their onsite worker accommodation centre.

Please note the admission requirements listed below. If you fail to meet any of the requirements at the time of application, your application will be withdrawn.

Admission Requirements

Any 18+ woman (or identifies as) who meets the following criteria:

- A legal resident of British Columbia and is able to legally work in Canada.
- Has successfully completed grade 10 (or Canadian equivalent).
- Is able to attend a four-week training program in Kitimat, British Columbia and work on a fly-in/fly-out shift rotation following training,
- Is willing and able to complete a drug & alcohol screening (includes THC) and fitness test.
