Position Summary: Reporting to the Social Assistance Worker, the Recreation Worker will manage the recreation gym and set programs for sports and leisure programs for Gitga'at members in Hartley Bay. The recreation Worker will schedule events, sports activities, and promote a healthy lifestyle.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee the recreation program by assessing recreation needs in the community;
- Ensure a range of sports, recreation and cultural programs are planned and implemented weekly;
- Create and lead activities for children, youth and elders;
- Prep, advertise and escort on camping trips and/or picnic day trips;
- Recruit volunteers, students and members to participate in recreation programs;
- Ensure activities and recreation programs are known to the community through regular postings;
- Ensure all programs are implemented within safety policies and procedures and legislation;
- Ensure Recreation Facilities including gym, kitchen, office are clean and sterilized at all times;
- Follow up on all programs and activities and make recommendations for future programs and improvement to facilities and recreation program.

- High School diploma or equivalent or a combination of education experience;
- 1 year of related experience in recreation, sport and leisure administration;
- Knowledge in events coordination and planning;
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills;
- Demonstrated strong leadership qualities;
